- Water (Class A):

- CO2 (Class B & C): Designed for flammable liquid fires (like gasoline) and electrical fires. CO2 removes the oxygen and cools the flames.
- Dry Chemical (Multi-Purpose):
  Effective against Class A, B, and C fires. These extinguishers interrupt the chemical reactions in the fire.
- Wet Chemical (Class K): Specifically for kitchen fires involving oils and fats.
- Metal (Class D):
  For fires involving flammable metals like magnesium.


## HOW TO USE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER (P.A.S.S. METHOD)

Pull the pin to unlock the operating lever.

**A**im low, pointing the nozzle at the base of the fire.

**S**queeze the lever to discharge the extinguishing agent.

**S**weep the nozzle from side to side, covering the fire's area.
